Introduction – We can see the nature of worship by examining our next Greek family of words. *Latria* and *latres* are used for translating Hebrew words that refer to the service of the Levites and Priests in the Temple. God challenged the entire Israelite community to *be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation...* (Exodus 19:6).
