THE MESSAGE OF LEVITICUS

<u>Introduction</u> – Leviticus follows the account in Exodus of the construction of the tabernacle. The focus of Leviticus is on sacrifices, priests, and holy living.

Leviticus 20:26

- A. Sacrificial Offerings (Leviticus 1-7)
 - 1. It contains instructions on how to make guilt, grain, fellowship, sin, and holocaust sacrifices.
 - 2. Repeatedly the text says they are offering an aroma pleasing to the Lord with these substitutionary sacrifices.
