A. God's Glorious Riches

Ephesians 3:14-19

1. Our posture in prayer may signify a complacent attitude.
2. The primary work of the Spirit is in changing our inner beings rather than changing our external circumstances.
3. Faith allows Christ to live in us and strengthen us.
4. We need God's power to grasp the multi-faceted love of Christ.
5. This is an experience of love that is beyond all rational comprehension.
6. God wants to fill us with himself.

B. We Must Not Limit the Power of God

Ephesians 3:20-21

1. God is able to do immeasurable more than we can ask in prayer or imagine.
2. This is possible because resurrection power is at work in us.
3. This promise of God includes all future generations until Jesus returns.
4. Our purpose is to bring glory in the church and Christ not self-glorification.

Conclusion – Congregations are usually all about programs and special events that they can do on their own. We must pray and surrender ourselves to Christ so he can unleash the power of God in us through his Spirit. We must become the creation of God.
