Scriptures for discussion: Luke 19:28-44, Colossians 1:15-23, Philippians 2:5-11

Sermon Discussion Questions:

1. How does the description of Jesus as a king affect our identity as a church? How does imagining Christ as a king move us to be better Christians?
2. Have you ever had an expectation of what God was going to do, but what actually happened was different than your expectation? Share this with the group, if you feel comfortable doing so.
3. Reflect with your group on Palm Sunday and upcoming Easter. Put yourself in the shoes of the followers of Jesus as they approached Jerusalem in the Luke passage.
  - What were their expectations for Jesus
  - How did their expectations differ from what happened to Jesus?
4. What did Jesus live counter to his time and culture? How are his followers called to live that out?
5. Read through the Christ Hymn (Phil. 2:5-11) with your group out loud. Share with your group the descriptions of Christ stand out to you from this passage.
