Introduction – A paradox consists of true statements that lead to an apparent or real contradiction in logic or intuition. The Bible reveals the God who saves us by His grace yet expects us to have a faith that works.

A. Abraham is our example of faith salvation.

Romans 4:1-5

B. Genesis contains the story of Abraham's faith journey.

Genesis 15:1-6

C. Abraham is our example of works salvation.

James 2:18-24

Conclusion – Our salvation is a paradoxical mixture of grace, faith, and works.
