- We will close our presentation with prayer followed immediately by an opportunity for anyone to ask questions or write questions that will be read and answered.
- 4. Sometimes when we have only a few questions then we will break into small groups to briefly discuss the topic.

<u>Conclusion</u> – This is an opportunity to become better equipped to answer these questions yourself. It also provides an opportunity to invite people who want to hear rational and clear answers to these foundational questions.
